## Red Star International Announces 'A Meeting of Sacred Waters 2024,' a global convening to advance Indigenous-led Water solutions

TUCSON, Ariz. – Red Star International, Inc. will host its global gathering of Indigenous voices at "<u>A Meeting of</u> <u>Sacred Waters</u>" to be held at the Isleta Pueblo Resort and Casino in Albuquerque, New Mexico on March 12-13.

"A Meeting of Sacred Waters" is a convergence of Indigenous worldviews, values, and perspectives concerning the health of the earth's water resources. "The evidence is mounting," said Aleena Kawe, Red Star International's founder and Chief Executive Officer. "Indigenous knowledge systems are key to designing a sustainable future for all."

Through the experiences of Indigenous Peoples from the U.S. and abroad, A Meeting of Sacred Waters explores Indigenous-led solutions to restore balance at the intersection of health and critical climate responses. "Indigenous Peoples' relational approaches are needed to reestablish water solutions that are sustainable, systemic and transformative," said Kawe.

Water is at the center of the climate crisis, according to the <u>United Nations</u>. Whether its unpredictable rainfall, rising sea levels, floods and drought, most of the impacts come down to water.

This important event brings together Indigenous leadership from across the globe, providing international examples of successful Indigenous-led policy, law, and stewardship. **Indigenous practices occur locally, but impact globally**. By coming together as a global community in support of our ancestral waters, we can begin to create systemic change through law, policy, and management practices that are centered on Indigenous values and worldview.

"We need these conversations," said Kawe. "We invite all those who envision a sustainable future."
